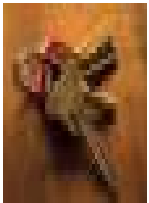

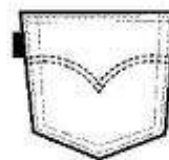

## Calling All Tutors – Pockets of Hope Free Tutoring Program to Begin in September



Zion's free tutoring program for area students in grades kindergarten through fourth grade will be held again this school year. The fall session will run from September 20<sup>th</sup> through November 17<sup>th</sup>. The winter/spring session will be held from Jan. 10<sup>th</sup> through March 1<sup>st</sup>. Volunteer tutors will work one-on-one with participating children to help them improve their reading, writing and math skills. The tutoring sessions will be held in Zion's Fellowship Hall every Tuesday and Thursday from 6:30 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. **Tutors need only commit to one night of tutoring per week.** A training session for the tutors, provided by professional educators, will be held prior to the start of the program.
